Purpose: To familiarize participants with the MUTCD and rules governing the public

What is this class about?

The Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD) defines the standards used by road managers to install and maintain traffic control devices. The Traffic Sign Handbook for New Hampshire Local Roads contains portions of the MUTCD, as well as some of the State of New Hampshire rules. The Handbook's standards and rules apply to traffic signs appropriate for use on rural and residential roadways in New Hampshire.

This workshop will provide participants with working knowledge of the MUTCD. Participants will understand the history of the MUTCD, its purpose, and the structure and language of the manual. However, the focus of this seminar is for participants to learn how to apply this information to their local municipality.

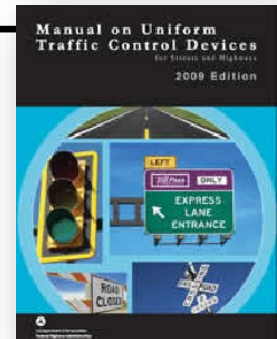
