# **Procedure for Determining & Requesting Assistance**



## Incident/ Disaster Occurs

Assess Damages/Critical Concerns

Respond to Event with Own Forces

#### Re-Assess

Do we have the resources needed to adequately respond to this disaster? Can we effectively protect the safety of the public?





### **Proclaim Local Emergency**

Declare local emergency, Activate local EOC and Emergency Management Plan, and Notify NHHSEM



Request Mutual Aid from other NHPWMA Members

Directly contact provider's authorized representative and communicate the information contained within Reference Sheet – Requesting Aid.

(Follow-up in writing as soon as practical.)

Provider responds with authorization/denial of assistance and communicates the information contained within Reference Sheet – Providing Aid.


(Follow-up in writing as soon as practical.

Aid Arrives in Recipient's Community.

Recipient (town/city) assigns work to Provider's supervisory personnel, Develops ongoing dialog concerning progress of incident, how long assistance will be needed.



Provider Documents All Costs and Activities.



#### **Re-Assess**

Will the current forces be enough to protect the safety of the public?



Recipient notifies the appropriate state agencies and requests state and/or federal assistance.
