


Who Has Access to What Boards?


- Anyone can enter information into and/or upload files to the following boards:
 - Mission Task Request
 - Press Release
 - Situation Report/IAP

- NH DOT & Municipalities can enter information into the Road Closure board.
- NH DHHS & Municipalities can enter information into the **Shelters** board.

- After Action Report: The information is only visible to the Position entering it, and select Positions at the State level.
- Activity Log: The information is only visible to the Position entering it, unless routed up.
- Position File Library: The information is only visible to the Position entering it.




Command Structure for the State Emergency Operations Center








