Purpose: Training ATSSA certified flaggers for their recertification.

You MUST have a current ATSSA Flagger certification to attend this workshop.

What is this class about?

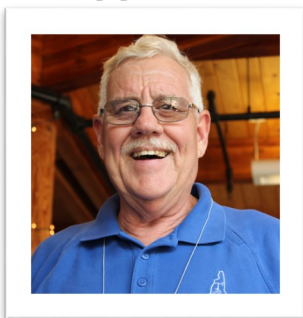
Flaggers are in a very dangerous and responsibility-ridden position, playing a crucial role in temporary traffic control. The safety of workers, motorists, and pedestrians is dependent upon the flagger’s performance. Since the flagger position involves safety, proper training is vital; flaggers are expected to pass a test to prove their proficiency and competence level. Students will receive their new ATSSA Flagger Certification in the mail (upon successful completion of the exam). This certification will be valid for 4 years.
