What is this class about?

Learn how to operate a grader with one day of in-classroom training and one day in-the-field “hands-on” training. Basic blading techniques and grader maintenance will be taught, as well as instructor-led training “on the grader.” The class will be small, so participants will have the opportunity to ask questions and interact with the instructors.
