



UNH T2 Advanced Master Roads Scholar Points Based Capstone

After completing 185 credit hours with UNH, begin receiving points for participation in the below activities. Accrue at least 100 points total, in addition to 200 credit hours of UNH T2 training, to achieve Advanced Master Roads Scholar.

Activity	Points Earned (minimum 100 points required)
Serve on a workshop advisory committee to assist UNH T2 in providing industry knowledge, input, content, and feedback to develop new, or revise existing, workshop titles and content	20 pts. each up to 60 pts
Complete a local road safety plan in your community, present it to your governing board, and share a copy with UNH T2	20 points (one time, up to 20 points)
Serve on a statewide or regional industry association board such as NHPWA, NHPWMA, NAWIC, NH Road Agents, or New England APWA for one year	20 pts. each up to 60 pts.
Present a session at a national or local industry conference	10 pts. each up to 20 pts.
Participate on a panel or roundtable to provide content expertise and local agency experience at one of our workshops	10 points each up to 50 points
Submit a Build a Better Mousetrap nomination	10 pts. each (no limit)
Participate in an industry workforce development event or meeting geared at engaging youth in public works awareness and career opportunities.	5 pts. each (up to 30 points)
Participate in developing and implementing a formal shared service agreement and provide a copy to UNH T2	10 pts. each (no limit)
Write-up an innovative project you've completed or another highlight for our newsletter or website to be shared by UNH T2	5 pts. each (no limit)
Share pictures and information for our staff to write-up a newsletter article or other highlight on a project you have completed to be shared by UNH T2	3 pts. each (up to 15 points)
