

UNH T2 Advanced Master Roads Scholar Points Based Capstone

After completing 175 credit hours with UNH, begin receiving points for participation in the below activities. Accrue at least 100 points total, in addition to 200 credit hours of UNH T2 training, to achieve Advanced Master Roads Scholar.

Activity	Points Earned (minimum 100 points required)
Complete a local road safety plan in your community, present it to your governing board, and share a copy with UNH T2	100 pts
Participate in developing and implementing a formal shared service agreement and provide a copy to UNH T2	Up to 100 points, points value determined based upon UNH T2 prior review
Serve on a statewide or regional industry association board such as NHPWA, NHPWMA, NAWIC, NH Road Agents, or New England APWA for one year	25-75 points depending upon association commitment, points value determined based upon UNH T2 prior review
Serve on a workshop advisory committee to assist UNH T2 in providing industry knowledge, input, content, and feedback to develop new, or revise existing, workshop titles and content	25 points each, up to 100 points
Present a session at a national or local industry conference	25 points each, up to 100 points
Participate on a panel or roundtable to provide content expertise and local agency experience at one of our workshops	25 points each
Submit a Build a Better Mousetrap nomination	20 points each, up to 100 points
Participate in an industry workforce development event or meeting geared at engaging youth in public works awareness and career opportunities	10 points each, up to 100 points
