Working Together During Emergencies for
Response and Recovery

- When time is critical.
- Demand exceeds resources.
- Special skills/knowledge required.
- Typically used during the response phase.
- Limited use in recovery phase.

What is mutual aid for

- Event occurs/emergency declaration.
- Request.
- Acknowledgement.
- Respond.

How does it work?

- Requestor
 - Local governing board declares they have an emergency,
 - Agency goes to web site and look through member agencies and resource list, <http://t2.unh.edu/ma>
 - Contact member agency directly,
 - Call “800” number and request assistance from an on-call board member,
 - Make contact, and
 - Forward support request letter.

Mutual Aid Process

- Providing Agency
 - Determine if your community is a member by searching the member list.
 - Determine if your community has adequate resources.
 - Determine conditions of support.
 - how long
 - Provision of fuel/food.
 - Expecting reimbursement for overtime.
 - Notify recipient that you can respond, both verbally and in writing.
 - Designate a lead person or supervisor sent to assist with incident and to work with recipient representative.
