ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:

Animal & Agricultural Wastes, Hazardous Wastes, Asbestos, Stumps, Septic Tank Residuals,
Automobile Gas Tanks, Junk Vehicles (including motorcycles)

MANDATORY SEPARATION FOR DISPOSAL/RECYCLING

ITEM	COMMENTS/EXAMPLES
Regular Household Trash/ NO Metal or Wood	Must be in Town Trash Bags
Aluminum Beverage & Tin Cans	Clean
Glass	Clean, empty, clear, green & brown. No window glass drinking glass, dishes, ect. No caps, lids or corks.
Plastic	#1 & 2 only. Rinse, remove caps and lids. No brown plastic liquor bottles. No black platter plates No hardened black plastic, etc. No # 3,5 or 7
Cardboard	Corrugated only, clean, no foam or packing material.
Magazines/Newspapers/Paperback Books	Clean, dry, no tied bundles, no hard covered books.
Mixed Paper	Junk mail, shirt & cereal boxes, other dry goods containers, office , paper, glass non-corrugated boxes. No wax coated containers or Corrugated cardboard. No bathroom trash or plastic bags.
Batteries	Automobile and Household batteries accepted
Brush	No stumps or logs greater than 6 inches. Place in designated pile.
Yard Waste	Not accepted
Ash	CLEAN Wood ash only. Place in designated pile.
Inert Materials*	Concrete, ceramic, porcelain, masonry. Place in designated pile: See fee schedule
Mixed Wood*	Clean, painted, stained & pressure treated. (See fee schedule for Construction Debris)
White Goods/Metal*	Including white appliances without Freon: See fee schedule
Waste Oil	CLEAN WASTE OIL ONLY
Asphalt Shingles*	See fee schedule
Furniture/Bulky Items*	Furniture, mattresses & brown goods; dehumidifier, refrigerator, freezer, or air conditioner: see fee schedule
Construction Debris*	Pressure treated lumber, creosote lumber, sheetrock, insulation. See fee schedule
Tires*	Auto, construction and heavy equipment: See fee schedule.
Computers/Electronics*	See fee schedule
Televisions*	See fee schedule
Light Fixtures*	Fluoresant bulbs, ballasts (must be removed from fixtures)

Scrap Metal: All scrap metal accepted except the following:

All heating oil tanks and gas tanks will be purged of residual fluids and the tanks cut in half prior to disposal. Automobile engines, transmissions, transaxles and rear ends will not be accepted. Call a local scrap metal dealer to dispose of these items.

Tires: A \$2.00 fee shall be charged for each tire. All rims shall be removed from the tires and placed in the scrap metal pile. If rimes are still on the tires, then an additional fee of \$2.00 per rim shall apply.

Brush: Brush and stumps under 5 inches in diameter will be accepted and placed into burn pile only. Any dimension lumber that is clean, untreated, unpainted shall be placed in the burn pile. All plywood, particle-board, wafer-board, pressure treated wood and dimension lumber that has been treated or painted shall be disposed of in the landfill. Please see Attendant if you have any questions

Wet Cell Batteries: Automobile /truck/other wet cell batteries are accepted. Batteries shall not be leaking.

Propane Bottles: Small propane bottles are accepted. \$1.00 for less than 20lb tank, \$3.00 for 20lb tanks, \$10.00 for tanks larger than 20lbs. Larger commercial tanks are not accepted.

Refrigeration Units/Air conditioners: Air conditioners, refrigerators and freezers (with door removed) are \$10.00 each.
